## ALL GUESTS, STAFF, AND VISITORS

- If you are feeling unwell, please stay home.
- When arriving to the venue, please have the following ready to be shown at your designated entrance:
  - Your enhanced vaccination certificate with QR code to show your fully vaccinated status.  
\*[Download your enhanced vaccination certificate here](#). Both digital and paper enhanced vaccine certificates with QR codes will be accepted.  
As of January 4, 2022, no other certificates, receipts or mobile formats will be accepted.
  - Government issued ID that must match the information on your proof of vaccination.  
\*Children under 12 will be required to be accompanied and supervised by a fully vaccinated adult.
  - Results from our [Online Self -Screening Questionnaire](#) which must be completed within a two-hour window prior to entering the venue.
- As of January 10, 2022, individuals with an eligible medical exemption will also be required to present an enhanced vaccine certificate with a QR code to access City recreation facilities including the TCC. Doctor's notes will no longer be accepted.
- Masks are required to be worn, covering your mouth and nose, at all times during the check-in process and while inside the venue except for when you are actively eating or drinking.
- We ask that you please practice physical distancing while in the check-in queues as well as inside the venue and sanitize frequently at various stations conveniently located throughout the venue.

## + ICE USER GROUPS

- The venue is currently closed for all ice user groups until restrictions are lifted. For future ice bookings or any questions regarding the Durham Central Adult Hockey League (DCAHL) please contact our Ice Sales Department.

## + EVENT ATTENDEES

- The venue is currently closed to the public and spectators are not permitted at events hosted at the Tribute Communities Centre. For more information on upcoming events, please visit the specific event page on our website for any updates specific to that event.
- For past events or events that are no longer able to be attended due to the recent restrictions implemented by the Province, ticketholders will receive information via email and it will be posted on the Oshawa Generals website.
- For future events, guests will be updated and advised of specific event procedures and protocols prior to the event through our Together AGAIN web page and/or pre-event emails so make sure your email is accurate on your account.
