# TRIBUTE COMMUNITIES CENTRE REOPENING PLAN



## - ALL GUESTS, STAFF, AND VISITORS -

- If you are feeling unwell, please stay home.
- When arriving to the venue, please have the following ready to be shown at your designated entrance:
- Proof of being fully vaccinated (and 14 days or more) <u>download your proof of vaccination here</u>.
- Government issued ID that must match the information on your proof of vaccination \*Children under 12 will be required to be accompanied and supervised by a fully vaccinated adult.
- Your results from our <u>Online Self-Screening Questionnaire</u> which must be completed within a two-hour window prior to entry unless you are a ticket holder attending a ticketed event, you must complete the <u>Ontario Self-Screening Assessment</u> and are not required to present the results upon entry.
- Masks are required to be worn, covering your mouth and nose, at all times during the check-in process and while inside the venue.
- We ask that you please practice physical distancing while in the check-in queues as well as inside the venue.
- Sanitize frequently at various stations conveniently located throughout the venue.

### - + ICE USER GROUPS -

- Ice users and spectators are required to complete our <u>Online Self-Screening Questionnaire</u> within a two-hour window prior to entry of the venue. All those who enter for ice rentals must present their final screening results to staff upon entry at their designated entrance.
- Youth under 18 years of age who are participating on the ice are not required to show proof of vaccination.
- Masks are required to be worn, except for when ice users are on the ice surface.
- 40 people total on the ice (includes players, coaches, and instructors. Game officials do not count)
- Please arrive 20 minutes early for your rental and vacate the dressing rooms 20 minutes after your rental has concluded to allow for proper sanitization/cleaning between rental groups.
- All clients will be assigned two dressing rooms. There is a maximum of 20 people in the dressing room. Players and coaches over the maximum of 20 for the dressing rooms, must dress in the designated overflow area. Showers will be permitted at this time.

**RINK 1** 

- Designated entry and exit is Gate 1. Designated washrooms will be located at end of North Hall.
- Entry to viewing area is through 103A and 105A.

#### RINK 2

- Designated entry is Rink 2 Entrance and exit is the staircase past dressing room 11 onto Red Tilson Lane.
- Designated washroom is located through the double grey doors at the North side of the rink.

### - + EVENT ATTENDEES

- For ticketed events, all patrons must complete the <u>Ontario Self-Screening Assessment</u> prior to entering the venue that has been developed by Ontario Health and mandated from the Durham Region Health Department.
- Masks are required to be worn, except for when you are eating/drinking in your ticketed seats. Eating and drinking is not permitted on the concourse.
- Please review our A-Z Guide which answers many of our frequently asked questions as well as provides information on our new Bag Policy, Smoking Policy and Re-Entry Policies as well as our Code of Conduct.
- Guests will be advised of specific event procedures and protocols prior to the event through our Together AGAIN web page and/or pre-event emails so make sure your email is accurate on your account.
